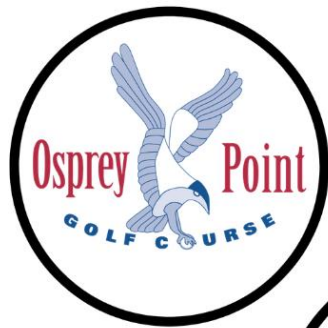

Palm Beach County Junior Golf Card

On behalf of Palm Beach County Golf, thank you for participating in the Junior Golf Card Program. We are very proud to have you as our guest and look forward to working with you this year. We wish you success in developing your golf game and having fun while doing so. The Palm Beach County Junior Golf card Program is available to junior golfers between the ages of 7 and 18. When a junior reaches the age of 19, they are no longer eligible for Junior Golf Card benefits. The Junior Golf Card Program provides junior golfers with; free walking access to the golf course on a year round basis, with certain time restrictions; access to certain junior golf events and activities; and the ability to borrow golf club sets if needed (on a first come first served basis). The Junior Golf Card Program provides substantial benefits at a significantly discounted price. The goal of the Junior Golf Card Program is to provide affordable opportunities for children to learn and play the game of golf.

Junior Golf Card Price

Free walking only golf on a space available basis*: \$50.00 + Tax

*Includes an allowance of 75 range ball baskets. Once the card expires or the allowance is used prior to the expiration of the card, the junior must purchase range balls.

Junior Golf Card Rules and Regulations*

The range and practice putting and chipping greens are available when the course is open with some restrictions. Golf course access is generally as follows:

*Junior Golf Card benefits cannot be used in conjunction with any other promotion offered by the Golf facility

All juniors must demonstrate playing proficiency and have a general knowledge of the basic USGA rules of golf and etiquette before they can play on the golf course. All juniors and parents must read, agree with and understand the Palm Beach County Junior Golf Card Program rules and code of conduct.

*Space available is defined as follows: a junior golfer is allowed to play golf on a walk-on basis only when tee times are available and when they do not displace paying adult golfers. Junior Golf Card holders are not allowed to book tee times at any time, including parents or guardians making a tee time with a junior. Any Junior Golf Card holder will pay the applicable adult rate when playing as part of a group tee time that was booked in advance. The ability of junior golfers will be taken into account to determine whether space is available. For example if a group of experienced, responsible, junior golfers who can keep pace with normal golf play would like to play and there is one tee time available between groups of adult golfers, they will be allowed to play. However, if a group of inexperienced golfers who would have difficulty keeping pace with normal golf play requests to play under the same circumstances, the golf course staff may determine that space is not available. If there is a question as to the ability of a junior golfer or a group of junior golfers and their eligibility to play on a space available basis at a given time, the golf course staff's opinion will prevail.

AT THE GOLF SHOP: Each player will receive a Junior Golf card. When you arrive at the golf course, you must go into the golf shop and present your ID card to the attendant behind the counter. He/She will issue you a greens fee receipt. Please sign this receipt and take the copy to the starter's booth outside of the golf shop. Range balls may be purchased at the pro shop at the applicable bucket price. **(50% off the standard bucket price, usually between \$3 - \$6, except at John Prince)**

AT THE STARTER'S BOOTH: Take your greens fee receipt (starter's ticket) to the starter and introduce yourself. Please mention that you are a Junior Golf Card holder. You may request your desired tee off time with the starter. While you are waiting, you may use the putting green. The starter will call your name when it is time to go. The starter will tell you what course you will play. You may be paired with other junior golfers to make a group. We generally allow groups to go out in pairs, threesomes or foursomes. Fivesomes are prohibited.

ON THE GOLF COURSE OR AT THE PRACTICE AREAS: Your time at Okeeheelee, Park Ridge, Southwinds, Osprey Point, and John Prince Golf Learning Center is very special. Please observe all the course etiquette rules and player rules. Our rangers on the course will help you in any way possible. They will also notify the starter of any poor behavior on the course. You have the privilege to play as many holes as you desire but must check in with the starter after each nine holes.

All juniors fall under the Palm Beach County Golf, Custom Fit Golf, Newell Golf, JCD Sports and Don Law Golf Academy code of conduct and disciplinary procedures. Course rules are implemented for your safety and the safety of all golfers.

Please play and act in accordance with the Rules of Golf and our Code of Conduct Rules below.

- Golf is a great game. Have FUN!!!!
- Tee times are available on a **space available basis. You may not reserve a tee time in advance.**
- **Juniors reserving a tee time in advance either with a group of juniors or adults, MUST pay the applicable public adult rate valid at the time of play.**
- Have respect for the golf course, your fellow players and adults. Treat people the way you would like to be treated.
- Put all trash in proper receptacles.
- Proper golf attire is required. Tee shirts in good taste are permitted. Female players may wear sleeveless golf shirts. Shorts must be no shorter than 6 inches above the knee. Hats and caps are to be worn with the bill facing forward.
- Please repair your ball mark on the putting greens and repair 2 extra.
- Please keep pull carts and golf bags off to the side of all greens and tees.
- Allow faster players to play through at the next teeing box.
- Profanity, club throwing, fighting, loud verbal outbursts and running anywhere at the golf facility is prohibited and will be an immediate first violation.
- Quitting due to poor play is prohibited. Please finish your round unless injured or inclement weather approaches.
- When the dangerous lightning alert sounds, ALL Juniors not playing or being observed by their parent or guardian must come off the course until the all clear is given.
- Play in groups of two, three or four players. Fivesomes are prohibited!!
- Leave golf bags outside of the Pro Shop. Please do not leave your bags in front of stairways or doorways.
- Please be considerate of other patrons.
- **Juniors who have reached the age of 16 and have a valid driver's license may request a cart but WILL be required to pay the applicable adult rate. NO free golf will be provided with the use of a cart.**
- Adults may request a spectator cart to accompany junior walkers. The applicable cart fee will be paid by the adult if using a cart.

Violation of these rules will have the following procedure/consequences: (continued on next page)

- 1st - Verbal Warning. Call to parents. Violation documented and office consultation with Golf Course Management.

2nd - Suspension from facility and any junior events at Okeeheelee, Park Ridge, Southwinds, Osprey Point & JPGLC during suspension.

3rd - All privileges for the remainder of the card are revoked. No refunds. Future applications may be denied.

Let's have a great time this year and make the junior golf card program the best it possibly can. We are here for you.

COURSE INFORMATION:

Okeeheelee Golf Course:

Holes: 27 holes total. Three, 9-Hole Championship courses: Eagle, Osprey & Heron.

Driving Range: Practice balls are available with your card or additional ball cards may be purchased at 50% off.

Practice Greens: Large $\frac{3}{4}$ acre behind clubhouse is restricted to putting and chipping. Short Game area by the driving range is for pitching and bunker practice.

Park Ridge Golf Course:

Holes: 18 holes.

Driving Range: Practice balls are available with your card or additional ball cards may be purchased at 50% off.

Practice Greens: The Green behind the starter's booth is to be used for putting only. Short Game area by the driving range is for chipping and pitching.

Southwinds Golf Course:

Holes: 18 holes.

Driving Range: Practice balls are available with your card or additional ball cards may be purchased at 50% off.

Practice Greens: The Green behind the starter's booth is to be used for putting only. Short Game area by the driving range is for chipping and pitching.

Osprey Point Golf Course:

Holes: 27 holes total. Three, 9-Hole Championship courses: Falcon, Raven and Hawk

Driving Range: Practice balls are available with your card or additional ball cards may be purchased at 50% off.

Practice Greens: Large acre behind starter booth is restricted to putting and chipping. Short Game area by the driving range is for pitching and bunker practice.

John Prince Golf Learning Center:

Holes: 3 holes.

Driving Range: Practice balls are available with your card or additional ball cards may be purchased at 50% off.

Practice Greens: Large green right beside clubhouse is restricted to putting. Short game area with bunker is available to the north of the putting green.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Pro Shop: Juniors are to use the pro shop for registration and purchase of merchandise. Loitering (defined as hanging around in excess of 5 minutes) in the golf shop is not permitted.

Pull Carts: Pull carts are available for individuals who wish to not carry their bag. Pull carts may be available. Fees

and availability varies by course. Availability is on a first come-first serve basis.

Restrooms: Okeeheelee: One located at the clubhouse on the lower level and two on the course (#5 Eagle, #4 & #6 Heron)

Park Ridge: One located in clubhouse and one on the golf course by #17 tee, #13 Fairway, #16 green, and #5 tee.

Southwinds: One located in clubhouse and two on the golf course by #10 & #12 green and # 6 & # 7 tee.

Osprey Point: Men's and Ladies rooms are located at the clubhouse and on the course (#3 Raven, #7 Falcon)

John Prince: Clubhouse only

Water Coolers: Water fountains are located at all of the clubhouses. There are also water coolers located throughout golf course.

Snack Bar: Specials will be available for the kids during the summer check with the attendant. You are welcome to bring your own lunch and eat it at the outside tables. Unfortunately, there is a lack of cool storage. You must provide your own coolers and ice in order keep lunch cool. We will do our best to safely store your coolers.

Rain Shelters: Okeeheelee: The Clubhouse; #3 Green, #4 Tee & #6 Tee on Heron, #5 Green, #8 Green on Eagle

Park Ridge: The Clubhouse and one shelter located by #2 tee, #10 green, #11 tee, #17 green, & #18 tee

Osprey Point: The Clubhouse, #3 Raven, #7 Falcon

John Prince: Clubhouse

Lightning: There are lightning detectors at all golf facilities. At the golf course if you hear a continuous solid tone this indicates that lightning is in the area. You **MUST** exit the golf course if your parent or guardian is not present. Parents or Guardians who choose to stay out on the course with their junior do so at their own risk. Rain shelters do not provide protection from lightning. Once the weather has cleared you will hear an intermittent tone which means it is clear to continue play.

I hereby assume these risks and agree to hold Palm Beach County, its agents, designees, employees, elected officials, Custom Fit Golf, its agents, designees, employees, and independent/sub-contractors; Don Law Golf Academy, its agents, designees, employees, and independent/subcontractors, JCD Sports Group, its agents, designees, employees, and independent/sub-contractors, Newell Sports, LLC, its agents, designees, employees, and independent/sub-contractors free and harmless at all times from and against claims, liability, expenses, losses, costs, fines, damages or causes of action of every kind and character, including attorney's fees and costs, whether at trial appellate levels or otherwise, due to their acts, errors or omissions resulting in bodily injury, including death, or damage to my property or the property of participant/renter incident to in connection with my rental of Palm Beach County golf carts, participation in golf programs, or use of County golf facilities.

I, the renter, participant, parent or legal guardian of a renter or participant, agree to defend, reimburse, indemnify, and hold Palm Beach County, its agents, designees, employees, elected officials, Custom Fit Golf, its agents, designees, employees, and independent/sub-contractors; Don Law Golf Academy, its agents, designees, employees, and independent/subcontractors, JCD Sports Group, its agents, designees, employees, and independent/sub-contractors, Newell Sports, LLC, its agents, designees, employees, and independent/sub-contractors free and harmless at all times from and against all claims, expenses, losses, costs, fines, damages or causes of action of every kind and character, including attorney's fees and costs, whether at trial or appellate levels or otherwise arising during, as a result of, in connection with my use of Palm Beach County golf carts, participation in Junior golf programs, or use of County golf facilities.

Other conditions:

You must be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license to rent a golf cart. Under no conditions are you allowed to let another driver drive the golf cart, unless approved by Palm Beach County Golf management.

A maximum of two (2) people are allowed in the cart at any given time. All passengers must be seated.

Anyone observed abusing golf cart rules and regulations will forfeit all rental privileges immediately. This includes but is not limited to; reckless driving, speeding, driving in areas not designated for golf carts (parking lot, greens, and tee boxes), or allowing underage guests to operate the golf cart.
